We accept most goods if they are clean, unstained, undamaged and in working condition for example Clothing, Shoes, Bedding, Linen, Kitchenware, Houseware, Books, Ornaments, Household Furniture including beds, mattresses, draws, tables & chairs, sofas and lounge chairs, bric-a-brac, good toys and collectible items.
